Hi Dan,

The folks from North Haven have been working with DMR (Nate Gray) who in turn has been working with a USFWS hydraulic engineer to come up with a fish passage design that would also increase tidal flow. The design you sent is from USFWS. The opening in this design would likely need to be enlarged a little to accommodate a fish ladder and to allow more than just high tide fish passage. It appears that this proposal might also enhance ongoing oyster aquaculture in Salt Pond.

So, we at DMR think this project has merit. Cost estimates are being finalized. If the cost is less than the In-Lieu Fee amount, monitoring expenses might be added.
