DMR understands that the applicant is proposing to install a line of six 10 ft. x 30 ft. seasonal floats that would extend northeasterly from existing floats. They would be 99 ft. distant at their closest point from the Pearl Restaurant floats to the north.

The area the floats would go has between 6 and 8 ft. of water at Mean Low Tide. The bottom is reported to be sandy/mud.

This project as proposed should not cause any significant adverse impacts to marine resources, traditional fishing, riparian access, or recreation and navigation.
